BY LAW NO 1 – CRC SPECIAL MEMBERSHIP CATEGORY – VISITING MEMBER

This By Law relating to Categories of Membership is made by the Committee under clause 3.2 of the CRC Constitution.

Membership Category: Visiting Member

Eligibility: The person must:

1. Reside outside the ACT and surrounding region;
2. Apply to the Club Captain outlining reasons why she/he should be accepted for Visiting membership;
3. Intend to row as a CRC visiting member on an occasional basis;
4. Be otherwise acceptable in the estimation of the Committee for full membership of CRC, either as a Senior or a Junior member;
5. Agree to upgrade their membership to full Senior or Junior membership as the case may be if, in the estimation of the Committee, the person is using CRC facilities in a manner and with a frequency that exceeds the intent of the terms 'visiting' and/or 'occasional'.

Rights and privileges: Visiting members will have all the rights of a Junior Ordinary member, including use of CRC equipment, and subject to payment of the relevant additional fees may enter ACT regattas and compete as a member of CRC.

Membership fee: The membership fee for a Visiting member shall be set at 50% of the annual Ordinary Junior membership, payable in full in advance. Visiting members who wish to enter any regatta to compete as a member of CRC must also pay an additional fee equal to the registration fees payable to Rowing ACT.
